<p>Specialised Studies provide students with an opportunity to engage in detailed study of specialized theological disciplines.</p> <p>In this area, 105 points are required: (7 units). All candidates are required to specialise in one of the three fields listed below, by completing at least 60 points from that field.</p> <p>Fields of specialisation:</p> <p>Biblical Studies Old Testament; New Testament; combinations of these.</p> <p>Christian Thought and History Church History; Systematic Theology; Ethics; Theology and Philosophy; combinations of these.</p> <p>Christian Life and Ministry Pastoral Theology; Spirituality; Liturgical Studies; Missiology; Christian Education; Ethics, combinations of these.</p> <p>Study of a second biblical or related language (Greek, Hebrew or Latin) is permitted in this section of the degree.</p> <p>Candidates who major in Biblical Studies will be required to take at least two units from other Fields.</p> <p>Candidates may complete a minor thesis of 12,000 words (30 points) in this section of the degree. The thesis may be specialized, or of an integrative nature.
